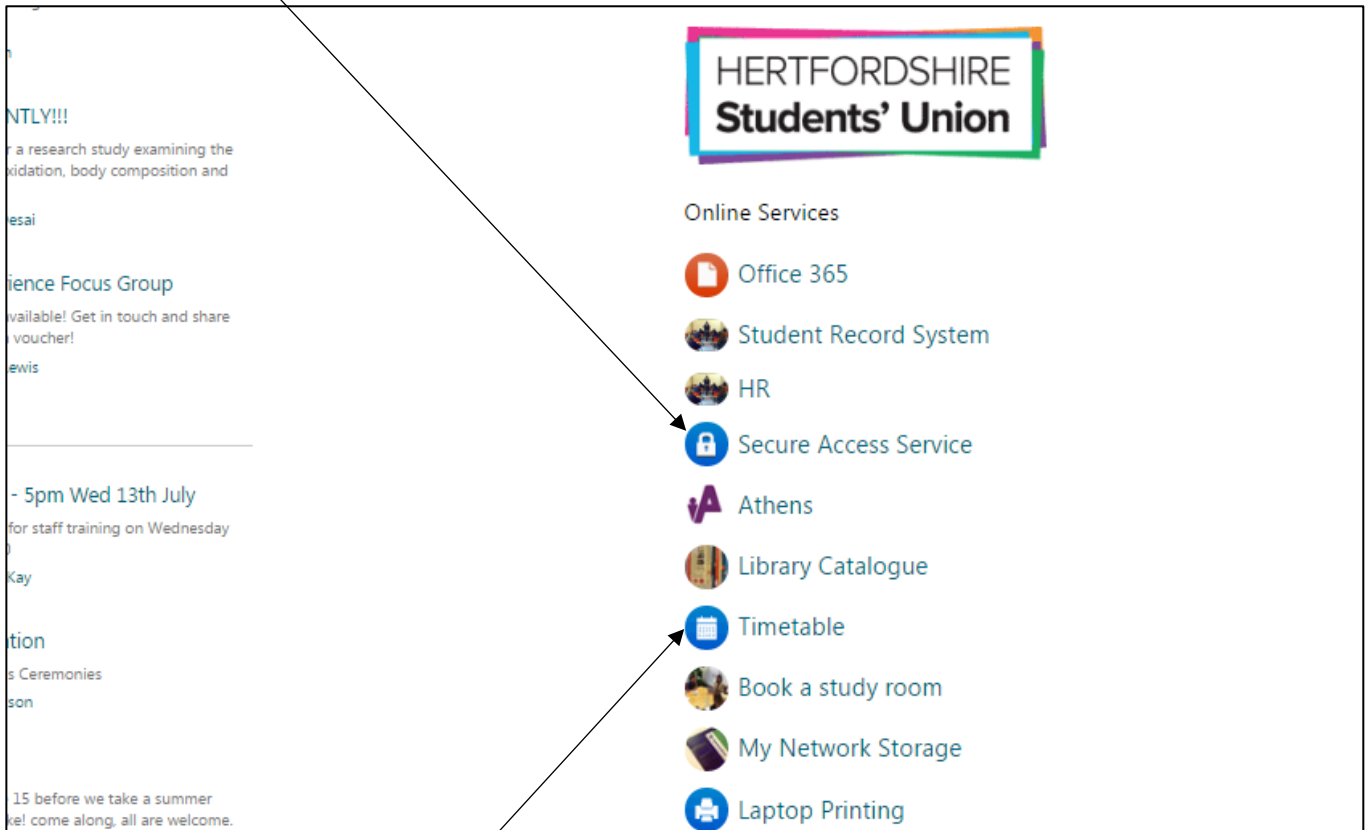


How to access your personal exam timetable

Login to StudyNet

If you are off campus or using WiFi on campus you will need to set up the **Secure Access Service – VPN – Pulse Secure** and login to it, instructions can be found here on your home page under Online Services



Next click on the link **Timetable**

On My timetable page look for **My Personal Exam Timetable** and click on the button **View my exam timetable** when it has been published your exam timetable will be displayed (if you haven't set up Secure Access Service – VPN – Pulse Secure you will be prompted to do so).
